



SYLLABUS: Lesson No. 01 to 08

NOTE: Read the following paragraphs carefully and translate into Urdu. Write on the lines given at the end of each paragraph. Use blue ink.

Paragraph#01: In the fifth and sixth centuries, mankind stood on the verge of chaos. It seemed that the civilization which had taken four thousand years to grow had started crumbling. At this point in time, Allah Almighty raised a Rasool from among themselves who was to lift the humanity from their ignorance into the light of faith.

ترجمہ:

Paragraph#02: “My dear uncle, if they put the sun in my right hand and the moon in my left, even then I shall not abandon the proclamation of the Oneness of Allah (Tauheed). I shall set up the true faith upon the earth or perish in the attempt.”

ترجمہ:

Paragraph#03: When Hazrat Muhammad (ﷺ) was thirty-eight years of age, he spent most of his time in solitude and meditation. In the cave of Hira, he used to retire with food and water and spend days and weeks in remembrance of Allah Almighty.

ترجمہ:

Paragraph#04: The period of waiting had come to a close. His heart was overflowing with profound compassion for humanity. He had a pressing urge to eradicate wrong beliefs, social evils, cruelty and injustice. The moment had arrived when he was to be bestowed with prophethood.

ترجمہ:

Paragraph#05: The flow of the Divine message which continued for the next twenty-three years had begun, and the Holy Prophet (ﷺ) had arisen to proclaim Oneness of God and the unity of mankind. His mission was to destroy the nexus of superstition, ignorance and disbelief, set up a noble conception of life and lead mankind to the height of faith and divine bliss.

ترجمہ:

Paragraph#06: And the Rasool (ﷺ) did go the way Allah Almighty had chosen for mankind. Imbued with Divine Guidance and firm resolve, the Rasool (ﷺ) encountered all the challenges with grace and dignity. In no time he elevated man to the highest possible level in both spiritual and worldly domains.

ترجمہ:

Paragraph#07: Patriotism gives people the strength and courage to safeguard the interest of the country and nation. For a patriot the sovereignty, integrity and honour of the country are supreme values on which no compromise can be made.

ترجمہ:

Paragraph#08: Patriotism means love for the motherland or devotion to one's country. A patriot loves his country and is willing to sacrifice when the need arises. The word patriot comes from the Latin word 'patriota' which means countryman. It is considered a commendable quality.

ترجمہ:

Paragraph#09: Patriotism, therefore, is not just a feeling. It is a live spirit that continuously inspires and guides a nation. In the words of S.W. Scott, a man devoid of Patriotic spirit is like the one who, "Breathes there the man with soul so dead."

ترجمہ:

Paragraph#10: To start with, let me state clearly that media is the most powerful mode of communication. It shares news and information with the people. Sometimes media spreads false news but generally it informs us about the facts around us.

ترجمہ:

Paragraph#11: There are two means of communication, electronic media and print media. The media includes film, radio, television, internet, books, magazines and newspapers. It provides us information as well as entertainment.

ترجمہ:

Paragraph#12: The preparation for this journey was made at the house of Hazrat Abu Bakr Siddique (رضی اللہ تعالیٰ عنہ). Hazrat Asma (رضی اللہ تعالیٰ عنہا) rendered useful services in this regard. She prepared food for this journey.

ترجمہ:

Paragraph#13: Hazrat Asma (رضى الله عنها) was amongst the early few who accepted Islam. She was the daughter of Hazrat Abu Bakr Siddique (رضى الله عنه) and step sister of Hazrat Ayesha Siddique (رضى الله عنها). She was wife of Hazrat Zubair bin Al-Awwam (رضى الله عنه), and mother of Hazrat Abdullah bin Zubair (رضى الله عنه). She died at the ripe old age of about hundred years.

Paragraph#14: Hazrat Asma (رضى الله عنها) will always be remembered for her courage, generosity and wisdom. She had resolute faith in Allah Almighty. Her life would always be a beacon of light for all of us.

ترجمہ:

Paragraph#15: During the perilous journey, it was very difficult for anyone to supply food to Hazrat Muhammad ﷺ. It was so delicate that the slightest mistake could have endangered the life of the Rasool ﷺ. This grand task was nicely undertaken by Hazrat Asma (رضى الله عنها), the daughter of Hazrat Abu Bakr Siddique (رضى الله عنه).
